



**Kristen Legor, PhD, JD, RN, OCN** is Vice President, Clinical Research Nursing Operations and Associate Chief Nurse at Dana Farber Cancer Institute (DFCI) in Boston, Massachusetts. She is responsible for the practice of Research Nursing across the DFCI continuum, sharing responsibility for the effective planning and conduct of clinical trials at DFCI, Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH), and Boston Children's Hospital - inclusive of adult and pediatric ambulatory and inpatient practice settings as well as DFCI satellites and affiliates. These responsibilities include the direct supervision of research nurses in the adult practices at the Longwood Medical and Chestnut Hill campuses, oversight of the review of new therapeutic and pertinent non-therapeutic research protocols, coordination of protocol education programs for clinical nursing staff and training of all new research nurses. Kristen has developed an orientation program for all newly hired research nurses, a research nurse residency program for newly licensed nurses, an annual Research Nursing Symposium and a research fundamentals class for DFCI nurses and BWH inpatient oncology nurses. She is Chair of the Dana-Farber/Harvard Cancer Center Clinical Operations Nursing Subgroup, has served as a member of the Dana-Farber/Harvard Cancer Center Institutional Review Board for over a decade and regularly collaborates with the DFCI Office of Human Research Subjects to ensure seamless implementation of clinical trials. Kristen is a member of the Oncology Nursing Society, including the local Boston Chapter, a member of the International Association of Clinical Research Nurses, serving on the education committee and a member of the Organization of Nurse Leaders.
